

by my friend Vinnie Greene, is shown in figure 2a. It is dated 16th Oct. 1837, and is an account to W. Dickson in Galt from a merchant at Port-Hamilton. The cancellation is in red and the mms and rate in black.

The second earliest postmark of Hamilton I have so far been able to acquire is shown in fig. 3, dated March 11th, 1840. It shows a paid 7 rate to Chippawa. The cancellation and paid are in black, white 7 is in red ink.
